



DEOCS REPORT OPTIONS

A summary of DEOCS survey results available to commands. This resource outlines quantitative and qualitative data results, details the different report types and downloadable formats, and defines the organizational levels at which results can be generated.

QUANTIFYING COMMAND CLIMATE

Quantitative survey estimates assess command climate as measured by 18 readiness enabling and readiness threatening factors. Custom and Service-specific estimates as applicable.



HIGH-LEVEL RESULTS

- » Take a top-line look at factor estimates (i.e., the BLUF)
- » Useful for an initial look to quickly gauge the status of a unit's command climate
- » Summarize unit climate overall and across applicable subgroups



IN-DEPTH RESULTS

- » Take a deeper dive into command climate estimates for a unit, a within unit subgroup, or rolled up across multiple units
- » Examine factor estimates by demographic groups, as reportable

QUALIFYING COMMAND CLIMATE

Qualitative survey results provide context for understanding quantitative survey estimates (i.e., DEOCS factor ratings).



OPEN-ENDED RESPONSES

- » Verbatim responses from unit personnel to open-ended questions
- » Adds valuable qualifications to pair with factor ratings
- » Useful for calling out exemplar statements when identifying action steps and briefing results



REPORT TYPES

Multiple products are available that present command climate results that can be tailored to your command's needs. The primary report types are:

EXECUTIVE REPORT

- » Figures of overall unit factor ratings and unit subgroups if specified in registration
- » Intended to be a snapshot of command climate, therefore, no demographic or item summaries are included

SURVEY RESULTS REPORT

- » In-depth factor ratings by demographic groups
- » Detailed item summaries for all factor items
- » Service-specific and custom item summarized results

COMMENTS REPORT

- » Verbatim written comments from respondents for each open-ended question asked

LEVELS OF REPORTING

Reports can be generated at multiple levels (more or less granular) depending on the command's needs.

SINGLE UNIT

OVERALL UNIT



- » Command climate ratings for the entire unit as registered
- » Applicable report types:
 - Executive
 - Survey Results
 - Comments

SINGLE SUBGROUP



- » Subgroup-specific command climate ratings
- » Applicable report types:
 - Survey Results
 - Comments

COMBINED SUBGROUP



- » Command climate ratings for two or more reportable subgroups
- » Applicable report types:
 - Survey Results
 - Comments

MULTIPLE UNIT ROLL-UPS

COMBINED REPORTS



- » Aggregated command climate ratings for two or more units
- » Applicable report types:
 - Survey Results
 - Comments

MULTIPLE FILE FORMATS TO FIT YOUR NEED



- » PDFs provide figures and tables with summarized survey results for various levels of reporting
- » Useful for printing and sharing with leadership
- » Executive Report only available in PDF format



- » Excls include all available estimates, more detailed than what is presented in PDF reports
- » Useful for creating custom figures and conducting additional analyses
